PUBLIC NOTICE FOR 2018-2019

Traverse County Social Services is in the process of developing the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) Biennial Service Agreement for January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019. Citizen participation is invited and encouraged in the development of this plan.

The Minnesota Family Investment Program [Minnesota Statutes 256J.626] requires counties to submit a biennial service agreement to the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) to receive these public funds.

The primary purpose of the Biennial Service Agreement is to identify and establish agreed upon outcomes and develop strategies to achieve these outcomes. We are seeking your input and comments. The review and comment period ends November 6, 2017.
