

**NOTICE**  
**WORK IN COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAY**

**Permits from the County are required** when working in County Road Right-of-Way for drainage work such as ditching and tiling, utility work, and driveways/approaches.

**Permits from the County are NOT required** for mowing and haying.

**MOWING COUNTY ROADS**

The Traverse County Highway Department will begin mowing bituminous surfaced roads on June 17, 2019. After July 4<sup>th</sup> the aggregate surfaced roads will be mowed. All mowing operations may include a top cut on shoulders and a side cut on in-slope. We reserve the right to mow the first eight feet away from the road surface, or shoulder if one exists, at any time based on State Statute 160.232. Noxious weeds will be mowed or sprayed whenever they can be identified.

Landowners are welcome to cut ditches for hay but **must bring a map of haying locations** into the Highway Department prior to **June 6, 2019**. Haying shall be done in a timely manner to maintain road safety.

Persons mowing road ditches **should not blow** clippings onto the roadway. The clippings cause problems in the gravel windrow.
