

NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES
TRAVERSE COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The following precincts located in Traverse County have elected to vote by mail ballot procedures in statewide elections as authorized under Minnesota Statutes 204B.45. All other precincts vote at their designated polling place on Election Day.

For 2018 statewide elections, the election dates and corresponding dates that the ballots will be mailed for the foregoing mail ballot precincts are:

Statewide Primary Election: August 14, 2018 Ballot Mailing Dates: June 29 – July 31, 2018

Statewide General Election: November 6, 2018 Ballot Mailing Dates: September 21 – October 23, 2018

Each voter registered by July 24, 2018 for the Statewide Primary Election and October 16, 2018 for the Statewide General Election will be mailed a ballot automatically.

Eligible voters not pre-registered by July 24, 2018, and/or October 16, 2018, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Traverse County Auditor - Treasurer's Office by phone, mail, or in person for an absentee ballot application. Call 320-422-7740 for further information.

Ballots may be returned by mail, delivered in person, or delivered by a designated agent to the Traverse County Auditor-Treasurer's Office, 702 2nd Ave N, PO Box 428, Wheaton, MN 56296. An agent may not deliver more than three "others" ballots during an election. Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except from Memorial Day to Labor Day when business hours are M – F, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.).

The Auditor-Treasurer's office is also the location for all absentee voting for the primary and general elections. An Automark voting machine will be available for those voters with disabilities at the absentee voting location.

In addition to the normal business hours, extended hours for mail ballot and absentee voting are:

Statewide Primary Election: Saturday, August 11, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.; Monday, August 13, 2018 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Tuesday, August 14, 2018 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Statewide General Election: Saturday, November 3, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.; Monday, November 5, 2018 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Tuesday, November 6, 2018 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

All mail ballots will be counted at the Traverse County Courthouse after 8:00 p.m. on the respective election dates.
