Traverse County Social Services is in the process of developing the 2016-2017 Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) Plan. Citizen participation is invited and encouraged in the development of this plan.

The Minnesota Family Investment Program [Minnesota Statutes 256J.626] requires counties to submit a biennial service agreement to the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) to receive these public funds.

The primary purpose of the Biennial Service Agreement is to identify and establish agreed upon outcomes and develop strategies to achieve these outcomes. We are seeking your input and comments. The review and comment period will end on October 16, 2015.
