WHAT IS IT?

The Child Care Assistance Program is a reimbursement program that helps working parents and students pay their child care expenses, subsidized by the state and county.

WHO QUALIFIES?

Working parents and students whose income is below 47% of the Minnesota State Median Income. A family co-payment is assessed on a sliding fee basis. Below are the income guidelines based on household size. Please contact Traverse County Social Services Department to see if you may qualify.

Insurance premiums paid for medical, dental, and vision may be deducted from your annual income!
