I. Project Objectives:

- 1. Develop a new courthouse to replace the existing courthouse.
- 2. Project Goals
 - i. Shared Reception Area
 - ii. Shared Waiting Room
 - iii. Improve safety of staff
 - iv. Maintain privacy of sensitive information
 - v. Improve building energy performance
 - vi. Add an IT technician and update existing technology.

II. Notes from the County:

- 1. This study is for a new building only. The existing building is planned to be demolished.
- 2. The study should include costs of utilities in project cost.
- 3. Use the program developed in 2011. This program was changed during discussions with staff.
- 4. Develop a plan that will meet the above requirements.

III. What has been observed

- 1. The water and sewer go to the south.
- 2. The phone comes from the north.
- 3. The electric comes from the west.
- 4. Cable comes from the west.
- 5. The plans indicate that the roof of the human services is designed for a 40 lb/ft2 snow load and the law enforcement roof is designed for a 35 lb/ft2 snow load. This means that we can not add additional snow load to those roofs.

IV. Design Approach

- 1. Co-locate county office to facilitate flexibility in providing county services in the future.
- 2. Plan that the building can have one public entrance. This can provide building security if required in the future. Additional entrances can be used by staff with access permission.
- 3. Departments that are not county employees but where the county is more of a landlord should be designed as tenant space allowing flexibility in long term use.
- 4. Maintain the court house square.
