

NOTICE OF ABSENTEE BALLOT PROCEDURES
2025 COUNTY SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION
TRAVERSE COUNTY, MINNESOTA

For 2025 Traverse County Special General Election, the election date and corresponding dates that absentee ballots can be requested are.:

Traverse County Special General Election: May 13, 2025 Absentee Voting Dates: March 28 – May 13, 2025

Absentee Ballots can be requested in person, by mail using an absentee ballot application, or online at the MN Secretary of State's Website. Ballots may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), delivered in person, or delivered by a designated agent to the Traverse County Auditor-Treasurer's Office, 702 2nd Ave N, PO Box 428, Wheaton, MN 56296. An agent may not deliver more than three "others" ballots during an election. Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The Auditor-Treasurer's office is the location for all absentee voting for the special general election. An Automark voting machine will be available for those voters with disabilities at the absentee voting location.

In addition to the normal business hours, extended hours for mail ballot and absentee voting are:

County Special General Election: Saturday, May 10, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.; Monday May 12, 2025 from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.; and Tuesday, May 13, 2025 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

All Absentee ballots will be counted at the Traverse County Courthouse after 8:00 p.m. on May 13.
