



Now Hiring: Youth Development 4-H Summer Intern

What is the role of the Summer Intern?

This position is designed to provide meaningful professional youth development work experience for the U of M student intern working alongside Extension Educator(s). An intern will be assigned projects or focus areas determined by program needs and if applicable meets the requirements of their degree program in order to meet internship course credit requirements. The intern will work with their supervisor to set goals, establish a plan to meet desired outcomes, and review progress throughout the internship.

Who is right for the job?

Candidates must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate college student, may not have completed their undergraduate program, and may not have graduated in the spring of 2025. The completion of at least two years of college is preferred.
